# Go Left Campaign



This campaign aims to improve road users' awareness and confidence around what to do in the event of a breakdown on a motorway, including those without a hard shoulder, helping people feel more capable and equipped should it happen to them, alongside important preventative breakdown measures.

If your vehicle has a problem, or you get into trouble on a motorway, stay calm and try to exit at the next junction or motorway service area. If that's not possible:

Put your left indicators on.

Move into the left lane.

Enter the next emergency area, or hard shoulder.

Put your hazard lights on.

Get behind a safety barrier where there is one - keep well away from moving traffic.
